- Double check your "Hazardous Weather" training at my.scouting.org. This training expires every two years. Hazardous Weather training is now required for all direct contact leaders to be considered trained. (Direct contact leaders are den leaders, asst. den leaders, Cubmasters, asst. Cubmasters, Scoutmasters, asst. Scoutmasters, Crew Advisors, assoc. Crew Advisors and Skippers.)
- If you have not completed your position-specific training, check <http://flaming-arrow.shac.org/training> to see if there's a class or two you might want or need to take at the Flaming Arrow District Training Day on Saturday, May 19th.

The Sam Houston Area Council geographically defines Flaming Arrow District (FAD). Our council serves approximately 50,000 youth and 19,000 adult volunteers in 16 counties.

The purpose of the council is to guide and support its districts for achievement of Scouting's purpose. Councils establish policies and programs. Districts carry out those policies and programs in their respective territories.

Districts are comprised of all chartered scouting units and the registered members of those units within its borders. Our district has 67 units.

Leadership for FAD includes

- Three volunteers (Key 3)
- At least one professional staff member from the council (District Executive or District Director)
- District Committee members which coordinates the functions of FAD
